Family of Choice provides a brief overview of Mercy Care's ACC-RBHA adult behavioral health system of care in Maricopa, Gila and Pinal counties. It defines terms or acronyms you might see or hear at health care visits or in the community. It helps members and family members understand how treatment plans are put together. It's designed to help support individuals in reaching their resiliency and recovery goals.

A "family of choice" means more than just relatives. It includes friends or loved ones, guardians, coworkers and others. It includes anyone who cares for and wants to support someone with behavioral health issues. This is a very important role in the life of an adult getting treatment for an SMI designation.
